Present: Mayor, Tina Sloan, Council members, Gary Owens, Gwen March, Joey Brock, and Kalan Miller. Attorney Michelle Jordan, City Clerk Tracy Walker, and Deputy Clerk Christina Barnett, Public Works Director, Ronald Wood, and Fire Captain, John Williamson. Council Member, Shawn Sanders and Fire Chief Mike Owens were not present.

FIRE CHIEF'S REPORT – given by John Williamson no fire calls, mostly MVCs; issues with the fire dept – Joey asked that everyone involved be at our next workshop to address appropriately

RECREATION REPORT – everything is running smoothly; Vernon will be hosting the girls district tournaments 6/21-23; one 7/8 boys team will participate in districts on 6/2; irrigation is working at the Sportsplex again; football registration will begin 6/1.

PUBLIC WORKS REPORT – dirt was just over \$25K; Dawkins is being destroyed by Anderson Columbia's dump trucks, calls to AC have gone unanswered; all water & sewer lines are in, work on lift station at Cook Circle will begin tomorrow then at Circle H; GCUC tied in to Shady Grove; Ronald inquired about the responsibility of the 79 issues – Joey asked the clerk to have supervisors at the workshop; Jimmy Cook inquired about how the bills would be adjusted which will be done before bills go out this month. Gary commented that R&B Construction did not have any drawings for the paving project ready, but should have them next week.
